Contract Title: **THE REHABILITATION OF AL-MOSUL 4TH BRIDGE CROSSING TIGRIS RIVER IN NINEVEH GOVERNORATE (Rebidding)**

The Government of Iraq has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the EMERGENCY OPERATION DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (EODP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **(THE REHABILITATION OF AL-MOSUL 4TH BRIDGE CROSSING TIGRIS RIVER IN NINEVEH GOVERNORATE) WITH A COST ESTIMATE OF (11,700,000) USD (ELEVEN MILLION AND SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND US DOLLARS)**. The Cost estimate is indicative, and bidders need to bid based on their own estimate. The evaluation of bids is as described in the bidding documents. The Ministry of Construction and Housing and Municipalities and Public Works/Roads and Bridges Directorate now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Rehabilitation of all items of project including but not limited to: (Removal of temporary bridge, cutting off the ends of tendons at the end of undamaged spans using the necessary lifting and shifting equipment on all piers to bring back the bridge deck to its original location, rebuilding pier 1 and 2 as per original design, construct replacement for the damaged spans and provide and erect new expansion joints).

Foreseen construction period is: **15 months**.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (July 2016 and revised in August 2018) (Procurement Regulations), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 3.14 and 3.15 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of **IQD 500,000 (equivalent to 425 USD)**. The method of payment will be in cash.

For the International Bidders, there is also the option of purchase through money transfer and the Bidding Documents to be sent by e-mail. If required, the bidding document will be sent by e-mail upon receipt of net amount of **USD 425 through money transfer via Western Union, excluding of any additional cost regarding the money transfer**.

RBD will coordinate a visit to the project site for the bidders.

A pre bid meeting would be held on at the address below on **11:00 AM, October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020**.

Bids must be delivered to the address below before **11:00 AM, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on **11:00 AM, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020**.

All bids must be accompanied by a "Bid Security" in the amount of 160,000 USD. (The bid security of a JV shall be in the name of the JV that submits the bid. If the JV has not been legally constituted into a legally enforceable JV at the time of bidding, the bid security shall be in the names of all future members as named in the letter of intent).
